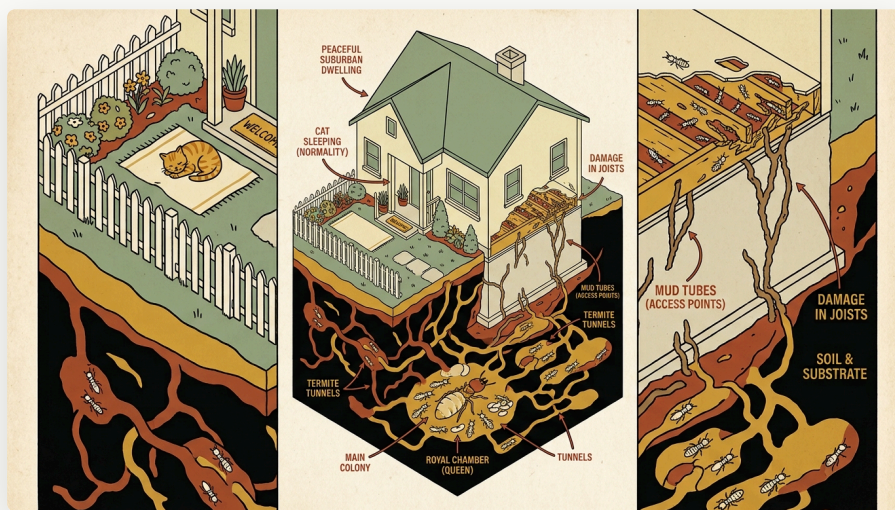

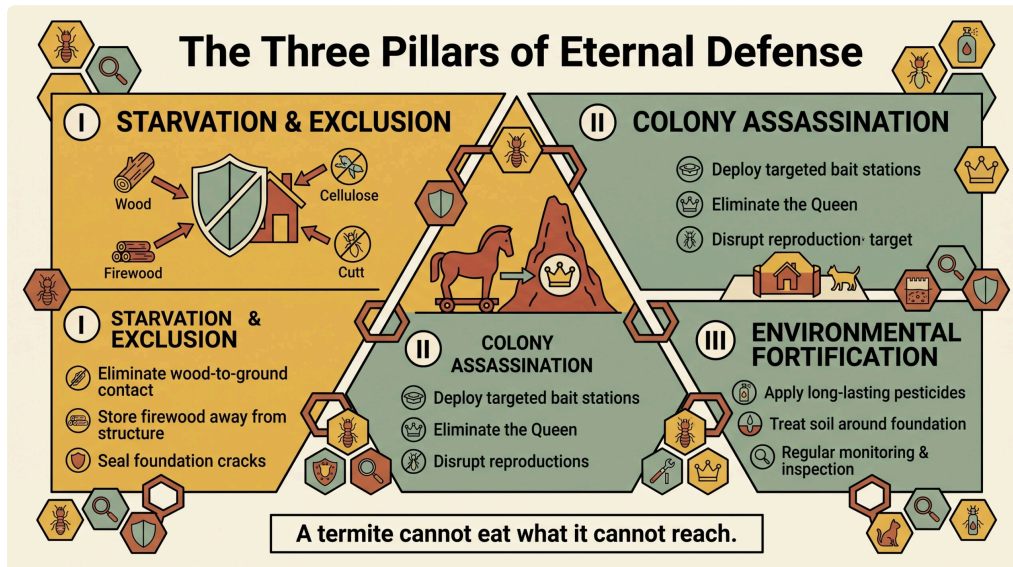

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# THE THREE PILLARS OF ETERNAL DEFENSE



Your home is a fortress. The enemy is a silent army of millions.  
Victory requires a **warfare system**, not a single trick.

| PILLAR | STRATEGIC NAME                     | CORE PRINCIPLE                                                                               |
|--------|------------------------------------|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| I      | <b>Starvation &amp; Exclusion</b>  | "A termite cannot eat what it cannot reach." Block every access route to food sources.       |
| II     | <b>Colony Assassination</b>        | "Don't kill the soldiers — kill the command." Strike the nest using the Trojan Horse tactic. |
| III    | <b>Environmental Fortification</b> | "Turn your fortress into enemy dead ground." Permanent, self-sustaining defense.             |

**FIELD NOTE:** The three pillars work together. Neglect one, and the other two collapse. This checklist helps you execute Pillar I immediately, and the full manual teaches you the entire doctrine.

***DARK HUMOR:*** MOCHI would like to remind you: "I may sleep 18 hours a day, but even I understand that a fortress needs walls and a plan."

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15 STEPS TO FORTIFY YOUR FORTRESS — COMPLETE EACH ONE

|--------------------------|------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|------------------|
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 1    | Relocate all firewood >6 meters (20 ft) from house, elevate on metal rack >30 cm (12 in) above ground.           | 1–2 hours        |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 2    | Remove all wood mulch within 30 cm (12 in) of foundation. Replace with gravel/crushed stone.                     | 2–4 hours        |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 3    | Inspect and replace all wooden posts, siding in direct soil contact.                                             | 1–3 hours        |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 4    | Dig out and remove dead stumps, decaying roots within 10 meters (33 ft) of house.                                | 3–8 hours        |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 5    | Seal all foundation cracks, exterior wall cracks with polyurethane caulk or epoxy.                               | 2–4 hours        |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 6    | Seal all utility penetrations (plumbing, gas, cables) through slab/foundation with stainless steel mesh + caulk. | 1–2 hours        |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 7    | Install 20-mesh stainless steel screens on all crawl space and attic vents.                                      | 1–3 hours        |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 8    | Inspect termite shield between foundation and wood structure. If missing, note for future installation.          | 30 minutes       |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | 9    | Purchase Borate (Tim-Bor / Bora-Care) and sprayer. Mix per formula in full manual.                               | Shopping: 1 hour |

**TOTAL ESTIMATED TIME: 20–45 HOURS (2–4 weekends)**

**FIELD NOTE — THE 30-CENTIMETER RULE:** No cellulose material within 30 cm of foundation. This “fire moat” forces termites to build visible mud tubes.

 **WARNING:** Fipronil is extremely toxic to aquatic life. Always use protective gear. Full safety protocols and mixing instructions are in the complete Field Manual.

# SAFETY PROTOCOLS & THE MOCHI TEST

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Every solution in the full FM-GHOST-o2 manual must pass the **MOCHI Test**: “Is it safe for cats, dogs, children, and all non-target living beings in your home?”

***DARK HUMOR MOMENT:** MOCHI weighs 4.2 kg and considers herself Supreme Commander of the Household. She has personally approved all biological and physical methods, but she strongly suggests you avoid spraying chemicals near her favorite sunbathing spot.*

- **Always start with physical exclusion and borate shields** — they are permanent and pet-safe.
- **Beneficial nematodes and *B. bassiana*** cannot survive in mammalian bodies — MOCHI can walk on treated soil after application.
- **When using liquid termiticides:** evacuate pets for at least 24 hours, wear full PPE, and never apply near wells or water bodies.
- **Never pour motor oil, bleach, or gasoline** into the soil — it’s an environmental crime and kills pets.

**FIELD NOTE — STORAGE:** Keep bait stations, borate powder, and sprayers in a locked cabinet. MOCHI may be lazy, but curiosity can still get the better of her (especially if you store tuna nearby).

*Remember: A safe fortress is a strong fortress.*
